

# Calcium Score Screening

*Evaluate your risk for coronary artery disease.*

A calcium score test is used to detect calcium deposits found in plaque in the coronary arteries. More coronary calcium means more coronary atherosclerosis, suggesting a greater likelihood of significant narrowing somewhere in the coronary system and a higher risk of future cardiovascular events.

## Risk Factors

Your doctor uses the calcium-score screening heart scan to evaluate risk for future coronary artery disease. Those at increased risk include individuals with the following traits:

- Family or personal history of heart disease, high cholesterol, diabetes
- Male over 45 years of age
- Female over 55 years of age
- Smoker - past or present
- High blood pressure
- Overweight
- Inactive lifestyle
